- 1. The 33<sup>rd</sup> Annual General Meeting (AGM) is being held through video conferencing | other audio visual MEANS (VC) in accordance with the procedure prescribed in circular NUMBER 20 | 2020 dated May 05, 2020 read with circular NUMBER 14 | 2020 dated April 08, 2020 and circular NUMBER 17 | 2020 dated April 13, 2020 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs and circular NUMBER SEBI/HO/CFD/ CMD1/CIR/P/2020/79 dated May 12, 2020 issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (the e-AGM circulars). The MEMBERs can attend the AGM through VC by following instructions given below of the Notice. For the purpose of recording the proceedings, the AGM will be DEEMED to be held at the registered office of the COMPANY at Plot No. 5501/2, Phase-III, Nr. Trikampura Cross Road, G. I. D. C. Vatva, Ahmedabad 382445, India. Keeping in view the guidelines to fight COVID-19 PANDEMIC, the MEMBERs are requested to attend the AGM from their respective locations by VC and do not visit the registered office to attend the AGM.
- 2. Since the Annual General Meeting (AGM) is being held pursuant to the e-AGM circulars through video conferencing | other audio visual MEANS, physical attendance of MEMBERs has been dispensed with. Accordingly, the facility for APPOINTMENT of proxies by the MEMBERs will not be available for the AGM and hence, the Proxy FORM, Attendance Slip and route MAP of the AGM venue are not annexed to this Notice. However, a MEMBER MAY appoint a representative as per applicable provisions of the COMPANIES Act, 2013 to attend and /or vote.
- 3. Copies of the Balance Sheet, the STATEMENT of Profit and Loss, the Directors' Report, the Auditor's Report and every other DOCUMENT required by law to be annexed or attached to the Balance Sheet for the financial year ended March 31, 2022 are annexed /attached.
- 4. The electronic copies of the DOCUMENTS which are referred to in this Notice but not attached to it will be MADE available for inspection. - 9. The MEMBERs desiring any information relating to the accounts or have any questions, are requested to write to the COMPANY on cs@dynaind.com at least Ten days before the date of the Annual General Meeting (AGM) so as to enable the MANAGEMENT to keep the information ready and provide it at the AGM.
- 10. The Board of Directors has recommended for consideration of the Members, a dividend of Rs.1.00 (10%) per equity share of the nominal value of Rs.10 each for the year endedon31\*March, 2022.

- 11. A person whose name is recorded in the register of members or in the register of beneficial owners maintained by the depositories as on the cut-off date, i.e. Tuesday,20-September, 2022, shall be entitled to avail the facility of remote e-voting as well as voting in the general meeting.
- 13. Members are requested to note that dividends that are not claimed within seven years from the date of transfer to the Company's Unpaid Dividend Account, will, as per Section 124 of the Act, be transferred to the Investor Education and Protection Fund (IEPF). Further, shares on which the dividends remain unclaimed for seven consecutive years will also be transferred to the IEPF as per Section 124 of the Act, and the applicable rules. Since, members who have not claimed/encased their dividend warrant for respective financial years are requested to write to the Company/Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (RTA) at least a month before the due dates, as under:

- 15. Annual General Meeting (AGM) be held through video conferencing (VC) or other audio visual means (OAVM): In view of the massive outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, social distancing is a norm to be followed and pursuant to the Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020, Circular No.17/2020 dated April 13, 2020 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs followed by Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020, physical attendance of the Members to the AGM venue is not required and annual general meeting (AGM) be held through video conferencing (VC) or other audio visual means (OAVM). Hence, Members can attend and participate in the ensuing AGM through VC/OAVM.
- 1. Pursuant to the Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, the facility to appoint proxy to attend and cast vote for the members is not available for this AGM. However, the Body Corporates are entitled to appoint authorised representatives to attend the AGM through VC/OAVM and participate thereat and cast their votes through e-voting.
- 2. The Members can join the AGM in the VC/OAVM mode 15 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation at the AGM through VC/OAVM will be made available for 1000 members on first come first served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairpersons of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the AGM without restriction on account of first come first served basis.
- 3. The attendance of the Members attending the AGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.
- 4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015 (as amended), and the Circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs dated April 08, 2020, April 13, 2020 and May 05, 2020 the Company is providing facility of remote e-voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the AGM. For this purpose, the Company has entered into an

- agreement with Central Depository Services Limited (CDSL) for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized agency. The facility of casting votes by a member using remote e-voting system as well as venue voting on the date of the AGM will be provided by CDSL.
- 5. In line with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, the Notice calling the AGM has been uploaded on the website of the Company at www.dynaind.com. The Notice can also be accessed from the websites of the Stock Exchange i.e. BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com and the AGM Notice is also available on the website of CDSL (agency for providing the Remote e-Voting facility) i.e. www.evoting.cdsl.com.
- 6. AGM has been convened through VC/OAVM in compliance with applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 read with MCA Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020 and MCA Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020 and MCA Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020.

#### THE INSTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR E-VOTING AND JOINING VIRTUAL MEETINGS ARE AS UNDER:

- Step 1: Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.
- Step 2: Access through CDSL e-Voting system in case of shareholders holding shares in physical mode and non-individual shareholders in demat mode.
- (i) The voting period begins on Saturday, 24<sup>-</sup> September, 2022 at 09.00 A.M. and ends on Monday, 26<sup>-</sup> September, 2022 at 05.00 P.M. During this period shareholders' of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of 21<sup>-</sup>September, 2022 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.
- (iii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.
  - Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.
  - In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.
- Step 1: Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.
- (iv) In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

- (viii) For shareholders holding shares in physical form, the details can be used only for e-voting on the resolutions contained in this Notice.
- (ix) Click on the EVSN for the relevant < Company Name > on which you choose to vote.
- (x) On the voting page, you will see "RESOLUTION DESCRIPTION" and against the same the option "YES/NO" for voting. Select the option YES or NO as desired. The option YES implies that you assent to the Resolution and option NO implies that you dissent to the Resolution.

- (xi) Click on the "RESOLUTIONS FILE LINK" if you wish to view the entire Resolution details.
- (xii) After selecting the resolution, you have decided to vote on, click on "SUBMIT". A confirmation box will be displayed. If you wish to confirm your vote, click on "OK", else to change your vote, click on "CANCEL" and accordingly modify your vote.
